

FERRARI IS THE MOST EXPENSIVE PLATE EVER SOLD IN TEXAS: COWBOYS, GOHORNS, RANGERS NEXT

January 14, 2011, UPDATED JAN 27, 2011 (All Across Texas) —About a thousand Texans witnessed state history at Cowboys Stadium Thursday night. The first-ever auction of license plates in Texas set records.

My Plates estimates that the 33 plates went for a grand total of \$139,400. Of that amount, My Plates estimates that \$78,195.00 goes to the state general revenue fund. On average, 60-65% of each plate price goes to the State.

FERRARI set the record for most expensive plate ever sold in Texas at \$15,000. The winner asked not to be interviewed.

COWBOYS was the second highest priced plate at \$11,500. GOHORNS went to for \$10,500. RANGERS brought in \$10,000.

Salman Waheed is a Dallas physician who purchased four plates: PORSCHE, T STARS, T DALLAS, and AMERICA, which he says is particularly special to him,



"I came to this country 16 years ago and became a naturalized citizen, and I believe that it is an honor to be an American citizen."

Jill Potts of North Richland Hills bought DIAMOND for herself, AGGIES1 as an investment she plans to sell, and BIG TEX for her husband, 'Because he's a big man, he wears a big hat, and he just *is* Big Tex."

The winner of Bidder's Choice is an Austin man who says he'll put the name of his business on his plate in 7 letters. He is the first Texan ever to choose a 7-character message "from the air." The other 32 auction plates were set combinations. Bidder Choice was 7 question marks that the winner gets to fill in.

Each plate is good for 25 years, with an option to renew every 10 years after that. Unlike other Texas license plates, Auction plates can be sold legally to someone else, so there's the chance winners could take the plate they won at auction and sell it for a profit--maybe tomorrow or maybe in 20 years.

Also at the Great Plate Auction, My Plates announced that 7-character personalized plates will be available to order at www.myplates.com, starting March 7 at 7am and ending March 14th at 7am. 7 characters are available only for 7 days. So there's a limited time Texans can purchase 7-character plates. See www.myplates.com for more information.

All plate messages are subject to approval by the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles.

Texans have bought more than 34,000 My Plates since November 2009, putting more than \$2.6M in the state general revenue fund.
