September 26, 2011 (All Across Texas) —Here are 18 new designs that are available now on official Texas license plates. From the turkey hunt to the roadhouse, we have Texas covered. Spurs, Rockets, and Wildcats. These plates are available at [www.myplates.com](http://www.myplates.com).

The Houston Rockets and San Antonio Spurs are the only two professional sports team in this plate release. The Dallas Mavericks plate is scheduled to release in a few weeks.

Three Texas school districts are represented: Bishop Lynch High School, Lake Dallas ISD, and Prosper ISD.

Eleven universities make up a large part of the new offering, ten of them out-of-state schools:

(With these additions, My Plates now offers specialty plates supporting nine teams in the Big 12 college football conference, nine teams in the SEC, and three teams in the Big 10. In all, ten of twelve FBS conferences have a college plate in the My Plates program.)



The National Wild Turkey Federation and corporate plates for Texas Roadhouse round out the list of 18 new plate designs.

With this new group, My Plates now offers more than 120 license plate designs, with partners and themes as diverse as our state. Texans have bought more than 61,000 My Plates since November 2009, putting more than \$5.6M in the state general revenue fund.

**TxDMV** The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) is charged with overseeing the state's motor vehicle services that provide consumer protection, assist motor vehicle-related businesses and raise revenue for the state.
